
Welcome to this month's newsletter, regarding the progress being made on the construction of the Mildenhall Hub, a major national project to deliver a better school, improved leisure facilities, and integrated community and public services.

The multi-million pound project will create modern accessible services to people living in and around the town, and from the surrounding area, and includes a new school, children's centre, new leisure facilities, a health centre, facilities for Suffolk Police, West Suffolk Council and Suffolk County Council, as well as a library, job centre and Citizen's Advice centre.











CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

Steel work has completed on three of the four zones with the final zone (zone one) currently being installed. The steel frame in its entirety is expected to be completed in September.

The majority of precast planks are in for zones four, three and two (which can be seen in the second picture). Zone one has been fabricated and will await the completion of the above steelwork before works can begin.

Works are also currently ongoing to the metal deck roof sheets. These have now been completed to zone three and will be progressed on zone four over the coming weeks.

Structural topping to zone three is also currently being poured.


The ground floor slab is also in the process of being poured and set out according to the architect's drawings.

Another next step for the project involves the beginning of the facade work, which will form the external aesthetics of the building. These works will start in early September and transform the way the building looks to the community.


