

Welcome to this month's newsletter, regarding the progress being made on the construction of the Mildenhall Hub, a major national project to deliver a better school, improved leisure facilities, and integrated community and public services.

The multi-million pound project will create modern accessible services to people living in and around the town, and from the surrounding area, and includes a new school, children's centre, new leisure facilities, a health centre, facilities for Suffolk Police, West Suffolk Council and Suffolk County Council, as well as a library, job centre and Citizen's Advice centre.









CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

With the main structure now in place, works to the cladding and metsec walls, are progressing well to zone 2 (pictured top left) and zone 4 (pictured below). The cement boards seen below are nearing completion with the final windows being installed.

The roofing teams are also progressing their works well, with the Vapour Control Layer nearing completion to zone 4, which will protect the building from condensation.


Reinforced concrete walls are being established around the swimming pool in zone 1.

Blockwork and internal partitions are being established throughout the building to form the internal areas for each of the different amenities.

Mechanical & Electrical works are now commencing in zone 3, which is an important milestone for the project.

Internal works to the remaining sections of the building will continue to progress in the short term, with the finishing touches also being made to the external cladding and windows to the Academy.

Mechanical and Electrical works will continue over the coming weeks as well as the establishment of some of the natural landscape areas across the site.
